## NOTES AND INSTRUCTIONS

Please read carefully as incomplete applications will NOT be considered by the Chief Immigration Officer. QUESTIONS MUST BE ANSWERED IN FULL. This application form must be completed IN DUPLICATE IN ENGLISH and should be used for a husband, wife and all children under the age of 18. Please note: Separate applications IN DUPLICATE from persons over the age of 18, who will be accompanying their parents to Zimbabwe, should be forwarded with their parents' application. Application forms must be attested before a magistrate, justice of the peace, commissioner of oaths, bank manager, senior civil servant, commissioned police officer, minister of religion, medical practitioner, Zimbabwe immigration officer, or some other person of similar standing. 1.

- 2. The under-mentioned documents (i.e. only ONE complete set of documents required for your duplicate application) must be attached to the application form.
  - Two full- face photographs of (i) the applicant, (ii) his wife, and (iii) each child under 18 years of age, if his wife and child or children (a) are accompanying him or joining him later, all of passport size and quality, taken at the time of the application and showing EACH person separately. One copy of each photograph must be certified on the back as a true likeness by the person who ATTESTS the form.
  - (b) A certified copy of Birth Certificate of applicant and, if applicable, of wife and children.
  - (c) One certified copy of Marriage Certificate, if married.
  - Documentary evidence IN ENGLISH of qualification and experience in the proposed occupation of the applicant. This should be in the form of COPIES of degrees, diplomas, certificates or testimonials, certified by the attesting officer to be true copies of the originals seen (d) by him, or a sworn statement by the applicant of his educational qualifications and occupational history. To facilitate registration with national industrial councils, journeyman are requested to provide evidence in the form of certified documents of having served an apprenticeship, or certified documentary evidence that a period of training equivalent to a recognised apprenticeship has been completed.
  - (e) If the applicant has been offered employment in Zimbabwe, documentary evidence must be submitted showing employer, occupation, salary and condition of service.
  - (1) Any additional information which the applicant considers is relevant should be submitted separately.

NOTE .- Copies of all documents referred to in paragraph 2 above must be verified by the person who attests the application. These copies will NOT be returned. Any documents not in the English language should be accompanied by a certified translation. Residence permits are issued subject to the conditions that the holder and any dependants shall – 3.

- comply with the provisions of the Immigration Act, 1979; (a)
- (b) produce to the immigration officer a valid passport on arrival in Zimbabwe;
- produces to the immigration officer on arrival in Zimbabwe a radiologist's CERTIFICATE of freedom from active pulmonary (c) tuberculosis, dated not more than ix months before production to the immigration officer. (Certificates are not required for a child under the age of three years.) (X-ray plates are not required.) If this document is not in the English language then it should be accompanied by a certified translation;
- (d)not engage in any occupation other than that stated on the residence permit, for a period of not less than one year from the date of arrival in Zimbabwe, without the WRITTEN permission of the Chief Immigration Officer, Harare.

4. Regulations provide that no intending immigrants shall be admitted to Zimbabwe unless in possession of a residence permit issued in terms of the regulations. The applicants is, therefore, strongly advised not to make preparations to leave for Zimbabwe until notified of acceptance as an immigrant by the Chief Immigration Officer. A residence permit may be cancelled, if the holder of the permit does not take up residence in Zimbabwe within six months of date of issue of 5. the permit. If the applicant is stateless, a statement in ENGLISH giving full particulars of the reasons for loss of nationality must be attached to the application. 6.
