1. FULL-TIME LECTURESHIP / SENIOR LECTURESHIP: (TWO (2) YEAR FIXED TERM CONTRACT)

1.1 TELECOMMUNICATION ENGINEERING (1 POST)

Applicants must hold at least a PhD in Telecommunication Engineering / Electronic Engineering / Computer Hardware Engineering / Computer Science or a related field, a Master's degree in Telecommunication Engineering / Electronic Engineering/ Computer Hardware Engineering or any other closely related field, and a Bachelor's degree in any closely related field with at least a 2.1-degree class. Applicants who can show progress towards acquiring a relevant doctoral degree may also be considered. The successful candidate must be able to teach Engineering Mathematics, Engineering Drawing, Computer Aided Design Techniques and at least three of the following modules: Computer Programming for Engineers, Digital Electronics and Systems, Analogue Electronics, Network Theory, Digital Signal Processing and Fundamentals of Radio and TV. Teaching experience at tertiary or university level and possession of a Postgraduate Diploma in Higher and Tertiary Education will be an added advantage. Successful applicants without a Postgraduate Diploma in Higher and Tertiary Education will be required to obtain the same within the first three (3) years of appointment.

1.2 TELECOMMUNICATION LABORATORY TECHNICIAN (1 POST)

Applicants must hold at least a Diploma in Telecommunication Engineering or Electronics, A Certification in COM3 or COM4 Laboratory, A+, N+ or other recognised certificate in engineering laboratory maintenance and supervision will be an added advantage. The successful candidate must have at least two (2) years of relevant work experience.

Reporting to the Dean of Engineering and ICT, the incumbent will be expected to:

- Maintain inventory of Lab and Workshop supplies, and make requests;
- Maintain Lab and Workshop equipment;

- Assist students to perform the necessary tasks while working in the Lab and Workshop;
